**SECOND PRAGRAPH and a photo of one specific modern building:** explain what sorts of things are mirrored/important to modern people based on modern architecture. Make sure to reference specific structural style and facts about modern society.

As well, make sure to choose one specific building from modern times to print out and include in your report in order to fully illustrate your ideas.

#### YOU WILL ALSO NEED TO INCLUDE A BIBLIOGRAPHY!

Because this project will depend upon you doing some outside research, make sure that you keep track of the resources that you use to help complete a bibliography. This is REQUIRED.
