Your job is to work by yourself or with a partner to find out information and design a poster or larger sheet of paper that shows the lasting effects that this exploration had.

Choose and circle one of the explorers from the list below – this will be your explorer:

Next, do a little research. You will need to display all of the following items in a way that is accurate, informative, interesting, and shows deep thinking about the lasting effects of the explorer.

- □ The Route that this explorer took plot multiple routes if there were multiple routes
- □ The ship that they were most likely to have sailed on
- □ Any sailing technology that they would have been likely to use
- □ The reason that this explorer went exploring were they successful?
- □ The things that they accomplished on their explorations
- □ Any important landmarks named after the explorer
- □ First-hand accounts of their travels (either written by themselves or by some person in their travels)
- □ Interactions with the native population (primary sources = even better)
- Overall benefits/detriments to the Old World
- □ Overall benefits/detriments to the New World
